With an ever-increasing network of distributors (over 200) regularly using our Gospel literature, and fresh opportunities opening up all the time, we believe the time is right to establish **Southern Africa Literature Trust (SALT)** to put the work on a steady footing to continue to grow in the future.

Of special interest - the Malawi Prisons Service has allowed us to send **Bible Correspondence Courses** and other Gospel Literature into all 22 of Malawi's prisons, reaching a ready audience of 15,000 inmates. There is an **open ear for the Gospel** among these men and women, and the prison authorities are very supportive in this. We have already printed an initial run of almost 1000 special edition courses with more planned shortly. To reinforce this initiative, we are working with the Prison Reformatory Schools to relieve some of their chronic resource shortages and have procured:

1000+ School Textbooks

1500 John 3:16 (Chichewa) Pens

1000+ Excercise Books

36 Scientific Calculators
